Introduction

We live in a culture that seeks to silence the Christian voice ...

God's Promise Of Blessing Is Coming True!

vv.1-7 cf. Gen.12:1-3

Gen.12:1-3 i) land, ii) great nation (many descendants cf. Gen.22:17; 26:4), and iii) blessing to all peoples on earth!

blessing in v.7 ... but the Israelites were exceedingly fruitful; they multiplied greatly, increased in numbers and became so numerous that the land was filled with them. (cf. Gen.1:22, 28)

God's Promise Of Blessing Is Threatened! vv.8-14

- v.9 ... the promise is a threat to the King
- $v.10 \dots$ we must deal shrewdly with them or they will become even more numerous (multiply further)
 - $v.11 \dots the plan is to enslave and oppress$
- $v.12 \dots$ the more they were oppressed, the more they multiplied and spread

The King's Hidden Plot To Destroy The Children Of The Promise vv.15-21

vv.15-16 ... a hidden plot to destroy

v.17 ... the midwives however, feared God ...

v.20 ... and the people increased (multiplied) and became even more numerous.

The King's Open Plot To Destroy The Children Of The Promise v.22

v.22, Then Pharaoh gave this order to all his people: "Every Hebrew boy that is born you must throw into the Nile, but let every girl live."

Conclusion

1) God's promise to bless Abraham still stands today in Jesus! cf. Matt.1:1, 21; 26:18-29; 28:18-20

God's plan is that through his children the peoples of the earth will be blessed in the gospel!

2) God's promise to bless Abraham in Jesus will always be threatened, but will never be stopped!

Matt.2 ... the promise is a threat to the King who secretly plots (vv.7-8) and who seeks to destroy the promise (vv.16-18)

Acts 7:17 ... a reminder to those who are threatening the promise ... it's unstoppable!

9:31; 12:24; 4:4; 16:5; 19:20 ... multiplied, increased, grew, spread ...

2:41, 47; 5:14; 6:7; 11:21; 14:21; 17:4, 12; 28:23 ... the Lord added to their number, increased, rapidly, large number, many believed, even larger numbers ...
