A Conversion, A Deliverance & A Salvation

Acts 16:11-40

Introduction

Acts – the good news of Jesus is for people here, there and everywhere, ... and it's for all kinds of people!

In Acts 16,

- Paul explains the gospel to Lydia
- Paul confronts the slave girl with the power of the gospel
- Paul waits for an opportunity to share the gospel with the jailer

The Conversion Of Lydia, The High End Fashion Supplier vv.13-15, 40

Note: it takes more than a gospel worker to reach a city, it takes gospel patrons who are generous and willing to underwrite gospel ministry with all their resources!

The Deliverance Of A Slave Girl, The Pimped Out Clairvoyant vv.16-22

Note: wherever the gospel is proclaimed it should bring change to wider society and culture, challenging and confronting brokenness, pain and suffering with the power of Jesus!

Note: sometimes Christian witness means patiently and joyfully suffering for the gospel and waiting for God to intervene so you can speak when asked about Jesus cf. 1 Peter 3:15
