Deacon

Members of St. Andrew's Presbyterian Church are invited to propose and give their recommendations on suitable candidates for the office of Deacon in accordance with the Book of Order of St. Andrew's Presbyterian Church.

A person recommended for the office of Deacon must be a communicant member in good standing of St. Andrew's for at least 3 years (for Malaysians) or 1 year (for expatriates).

In the process of recommending a person for office, it is vital to consider the qualities of a person that will be helpful in the respective offices. These qualities are found in Scripture.

The list of qualities for Deacon can be found in 1 Timothy 3: 8-13:

“Deacons, likewise, are to be men worthy of respect, sincere, not indulging in much wine, and not pursuing dishonest gain. They must keep hold of the deep truths of the faith with a clear conscience. They must first be tested; and then, if there is nothing against them, let them serve as deacons. In the same way, their wives are to be women worthy of respect, not malicious talkers but temperate and trustworthy in everything. A deacon must be the husband of but one wife and must manage his children and his household well. Those who have served well gain an excellent standing and great assurance in their faith in Christ Jesus.”
