The Rejection of the Savior (Exodus 2:11-25)

Introduction

We hear his name in 1:10 ... and we expect great things ...

**Moses Identifies With And Acts To Rescue His People
vv. 11-12**

cf. Acts.7:23-25; Heb.11:24-25

**Moses The Rescuer Is Rejected By His Own People
vv.13-14a** cf. Acts 7:26-28

Moses The Rescuer Goes Into Exile vv.2:14b-15

cf. Acts 7:29

Moses Acts To Rescue Again ... vv.16-19

**Moses Now Lives As A Foreigner In A Foreign Land
vv.20-22**

**God Hears The Cry Of His People And Remembers His
'Covenant' vv.23-25**

Conclusion

**God provided a Saviour in Moses, but his people kept
rejecting him!**

**... and they continue to do so to Jesus, God's Savior
who has come! Acts 7:51-53**

In Jesus, we have a Saviour greater than Moses!
